



## SETTING A NEW COMBINATION




This resettable combination padlock is set to open at 0-0-0, even though dials may be positioned at other numbers.

### Step 1

Turn the dials to 0-0-0, press the button to release the shackle.

### Step 2

Use a sharp object to push the Reset Button push and hold the reset button down, then set the dials to your new combination. (DO NOT LET GO OF THE BUTTON WHILE SETTING THE DIALS)



### Step 3

Release the Reset Button. Your lock is now ready to open with the new combination.

### Step 4

Test Lock is Functioning with the new combination before using.

Keep your combination in a safe and accessible place for future reference.

## Opening the Address Cover

### Step 1


Turn the dials to the opening combination.

### Step 2

Push the button and slide the cover out of the lock body.

### Step 3

Write your personal information on the label then push the cover back into its original position until you hear a click.



## NOTE:



The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) screeners and airline check-in staff at airports are trained to recognize the Travel Sentry® logo. They understand that baggage with locks displaying this mark are permitted to remain locked.

TSA screeners have access to special codes that allow them to open those locks in the event that the baggage must be opened for inspection. With Travel Sentry® Approved locks the TSA can screen checked baggage faster, without having to break open locks.
